****Organist's fees:** *The quoted £112 fee is solely for an organist to play at a wedding. Under the Musicians' Union copyright regulations, if the service is video recorded, the organist is entitled to a double fee to cover: his/her visual performance rights; and to pay composer(s) royalties as necessary. Guests making amateur recordings without prior warning are contravening copyright law, even if a professional video is not being made. St Peter's will, therefore, request two separate cheques payable to the organist, each for £112. If there is no video recording (professional or amateur) during the service, one of these cheques will be returned after your wedding. The person taking the service will be responsible for making that decision. Revd Charles Draper, Vicar.*
