Who are we?

Sunday Explorers is the children's group at St Peter's Church for children up to ten-years old which takes place during the 10.00 am service. Parents are welcome to come with young children, or children can come on their own if they are happy to whilst their parents attend the service.

Where and when do we meet?

We meet in the Old School Room at the back of the church, through the Link, from 9.50 am for toast and coffee with time to chat and catch up with each other and welcome new people.

What do we do?

We use songs, games, stories, drama, art and craft, cooking and prayer to explore the Bible and the Christian faith.

We join the church service at approximately 10.45 am for Holy Communion and parents are welcome to take their child/ren for a prayer of blessing at the altar rail. We have a children's area in the church where there are toys, books and colouring. Towards the end of the service we are invited to go the front and tell the church what we have been doing.

Family Services

We have a Church Family Service generally the third Sunday of the month, but do check the term card. This is an all-age service with an interactive talk and children's activities, a singing group (join us at 9.15 am for rehearsal) and shortened Holy Communion. This replaces the children's groups.

Refreshments

You are welcome to join us for drinks and biscuits after the service. Please ensure children do not enter the kitchen area or run around inside for safety reasons.
